We are so proud of their achievements.

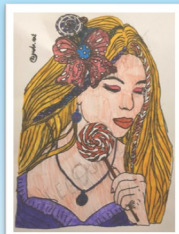

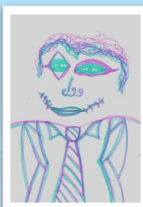


We received Molly's medal and certificate today from her mini London marathon challenge. We are told that she is the youngest person to have completed it. We are so proud!

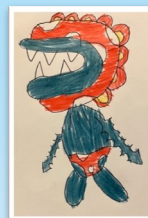

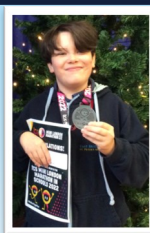
