Smart Watches/Mobiles

Ear Piercing

It is a firm recommendation from St Peter's Academy that if a child has their ears pierced during term time, they should bring microporous tape to cover their earrings for PE lessons. Recent health and safety recommendations are to consider less sticky alternatives to plasters. Generally, it is recommended to cover pierced ears for any sporting activity. Notts CC go further and do not allow earrings in their swimming pools / swimming lessons at all.

With this in mind, and to minimise risk, children will be asked to take their earrings out for all PE and sports activities (or tape ears up), ultimately to ensure their own and other pupils' safety.

Ear studs are acceptable in school but not hooped earrings or any type of dangling earrings in school.

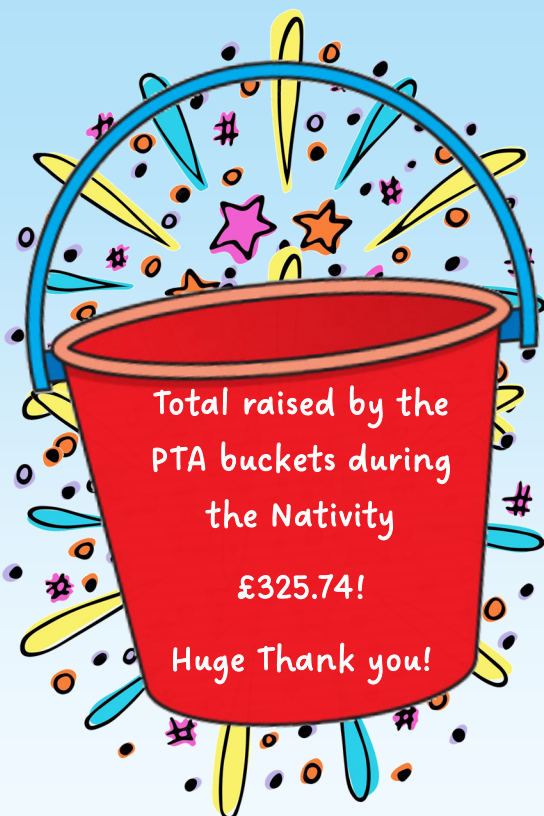
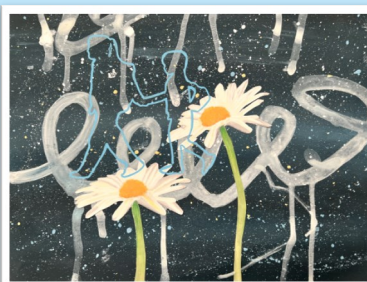
