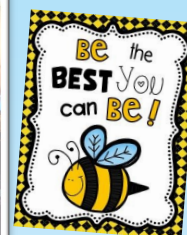


## Young Voices Choir, Birmingham:

Apologies that the menu for this half term caused a little confusion this week.

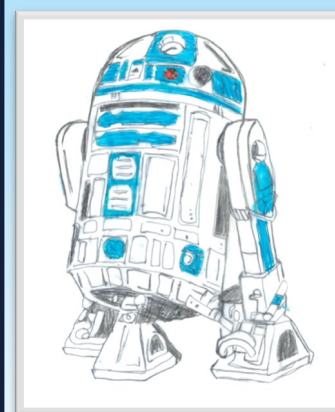

## Year 3 Year 4



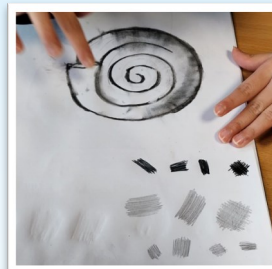
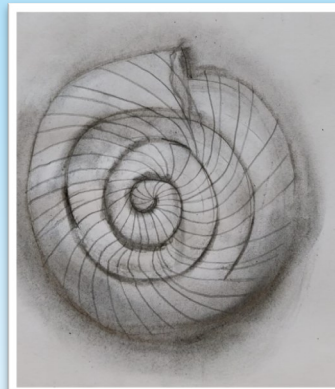
Year 3 and Year 4 have been learning how to make a clay pot and then sketching it.
