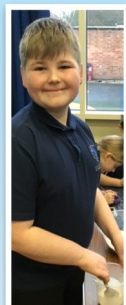


Year 2 Weather motifs created by children in Mrs Gilbey's class!

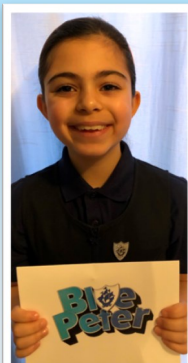


Out of School Achievements
