Ofcom Children and Parents: Media Use and Attitudes Report 2022 According to Ofcom's Media Use and Attitudes Report, 33% of 5-7 year olds and 60% of 8-11 year olds had their own profile on at least one social media app or site, despite the age rating being over 13.

62% of children aged 8-17 had more than one profile and only 42% of parents of children aged 3-17 knew the age requirements for social media apps.

Parent Zone, Internet Matters and Common Sense Media all have advice and rating information for apps. Remember to be curious when children are speaking about the apps and sites they access – if you are unfamiliar with what the children are referring to, you can check age-ratings and suitability using our linked page. 
