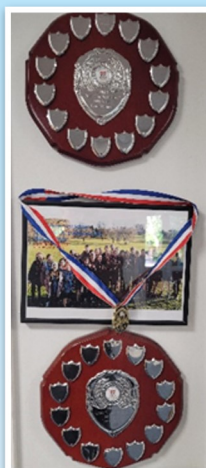

Bertie has completed level 1 swim and is now in level 2!

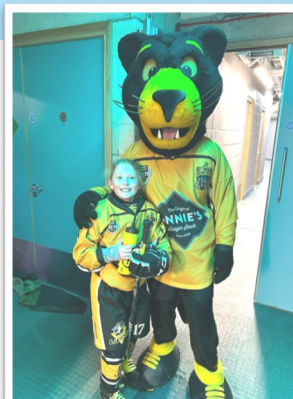
