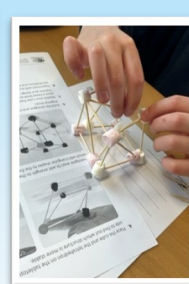
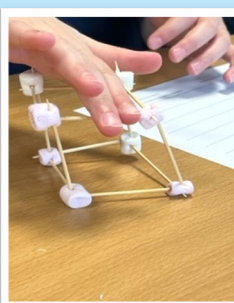

We have been exploring structures in D and T. We are looking at greenhouses. We explored how to make the structure stronger using diagonals.



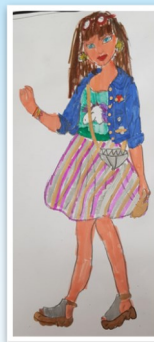

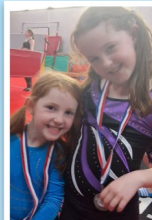
A huge congratulations to Hugo for completing Swim 2! Well done Hugo, we are all very proud of you, keep up the good work!!!

Charlotte (Yr 1) was really pleased to be awarded a bronze medal in her gymnastics competition last week. We're very proud of her!



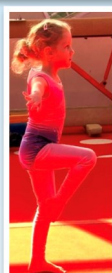
Olivia competed in a gymnastics competition and was awarded a Gold medal. She was very proud of herself and we are too!
