Class structure for September 2023-2024

Classes and class structure is decided by the Head Teacher. Parents will receive a letter next week informing you of your child's class teacher for September. From September there will be, three classes in Key Stage 1, three classes in Lower Key Stage 2 and two classes in Upper Key Stage 2. Our Reception class will continue to be taught by two teachers in the same space, with Preschool in the same building in the adjacent classroom. 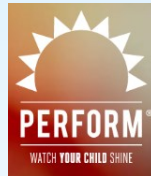


Drama Workshop



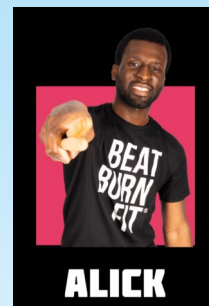
The Year Three children had great fun this week with Jade from Perform.

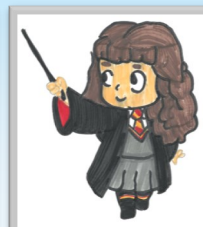
