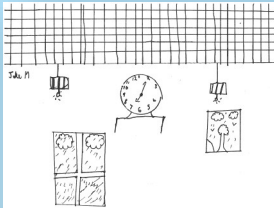

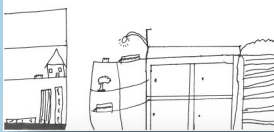

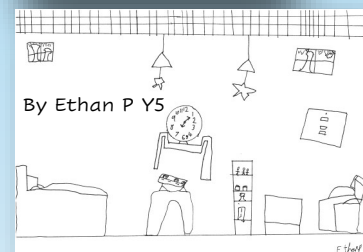

ART LEGACY PROJECT between St Peter's and Toot Hill children

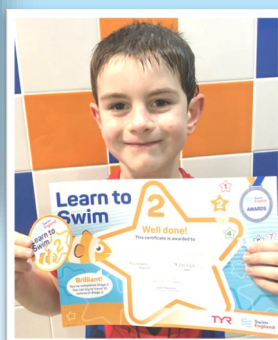
This term and next term we have a special Art Legacy Project between Toot Hill and St Peter's children being created.
