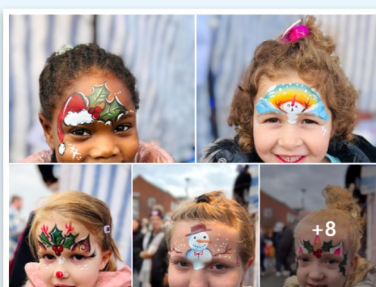

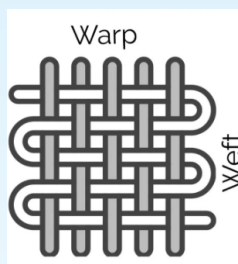
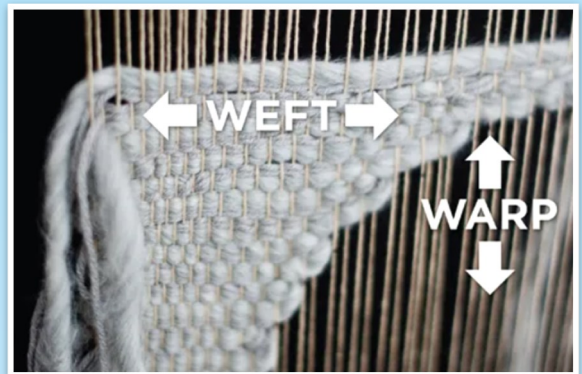

We're so proud of Oliver being awarded his level 4 gymnastics badge as he's worked really hard!

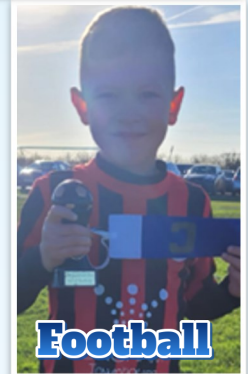
