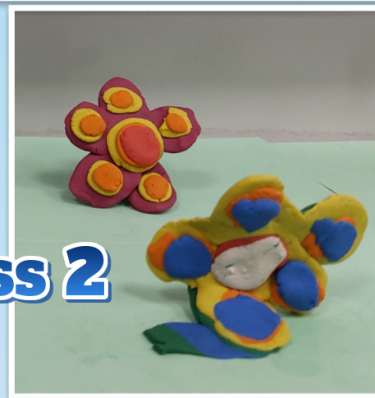

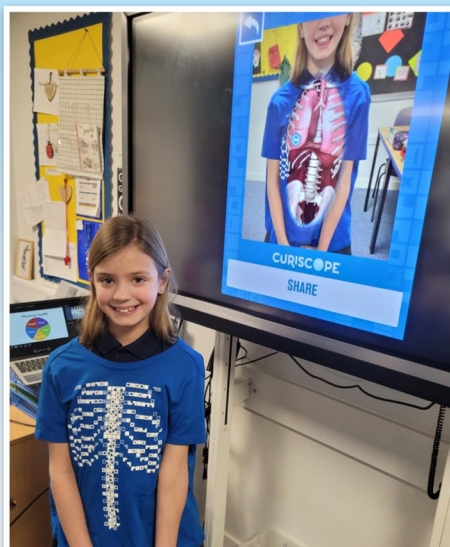

Alicia has been working hard on her gymnastics techniques and has achieved her level 3 proficiency award. We are so proud of you. Well done.



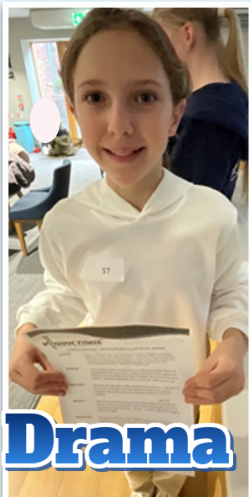
## Gymnastics
