


BRITISH SCIENCE WEEK 2024 – SMASHING STEROTYPES!

Can you build a tower higher than 45cm? Have a go at home and send in your photos.
















































What materials would you use next time? Hot glue gun. Paper/card. Marshmallows for the tower structure








































The theme in Bible Explorers this week was Easter People (a kind heart) - What it means to be Easter People.









