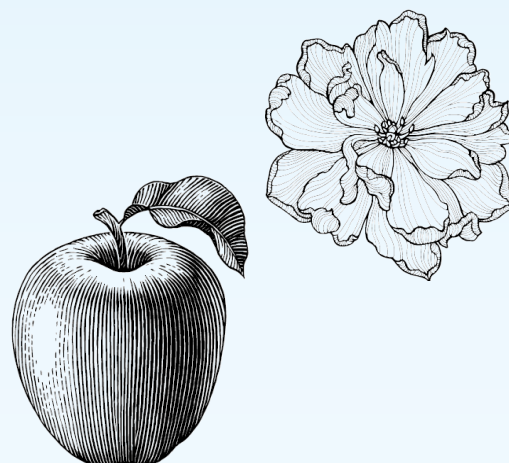
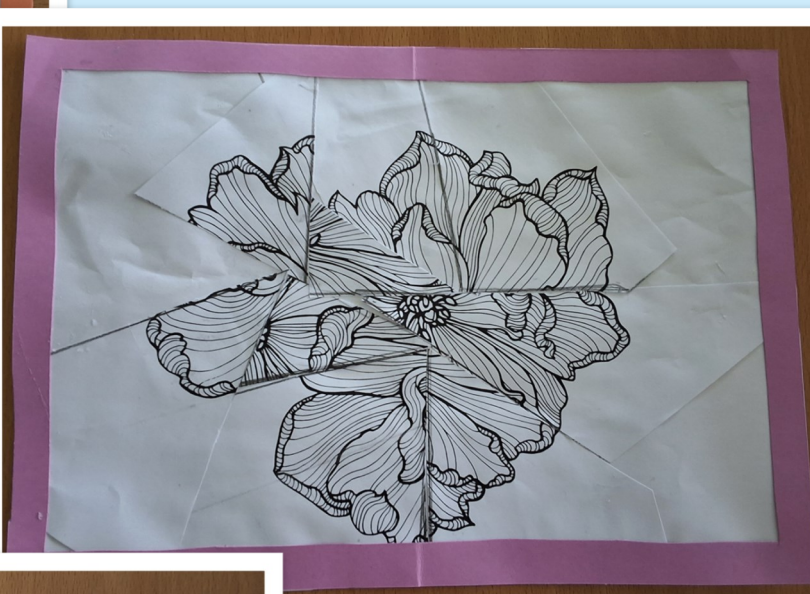
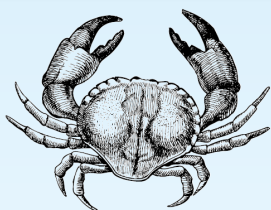
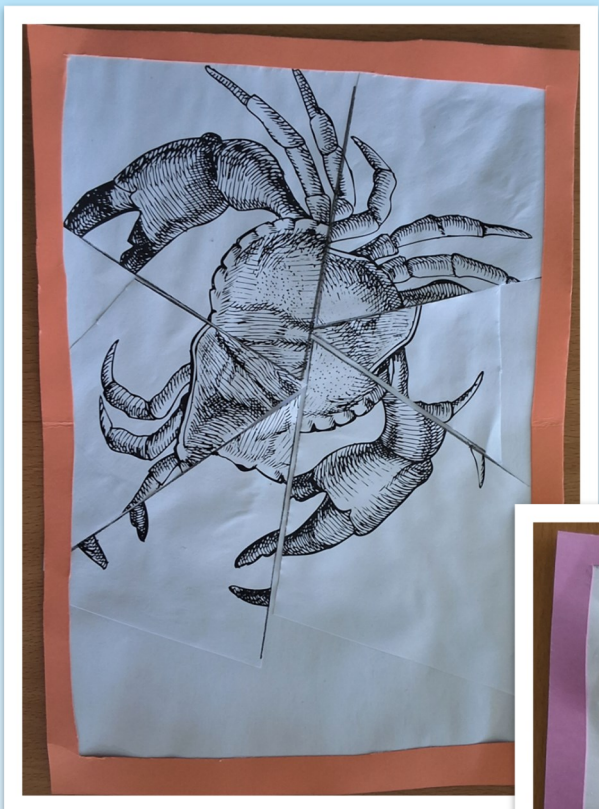
Over Easter, LKS2 were challenged with getting outdoors and engaging with the wildlife in their locality. Here's what some of our children have been up to.

Some Year 4 boys have created Bug Club which takes place during Mindful Playground



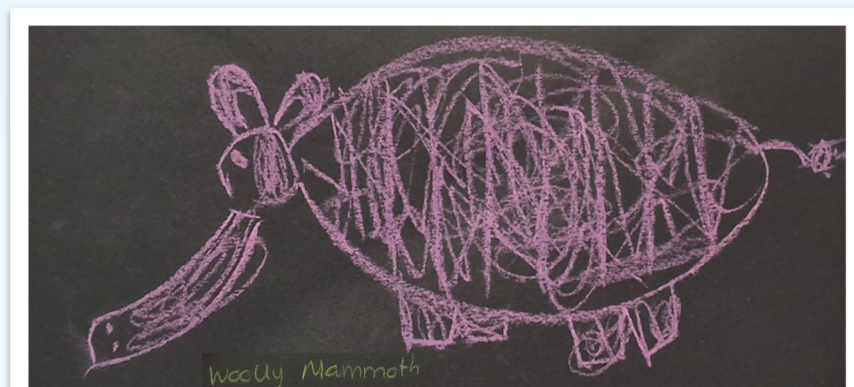
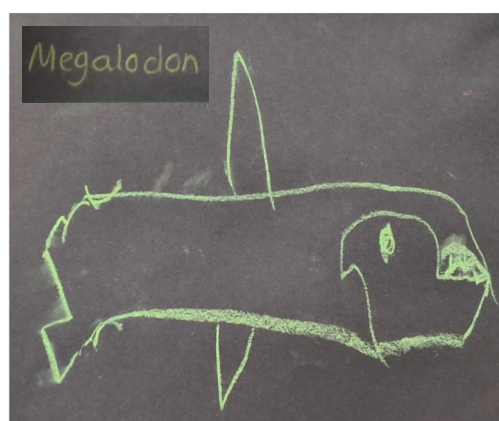
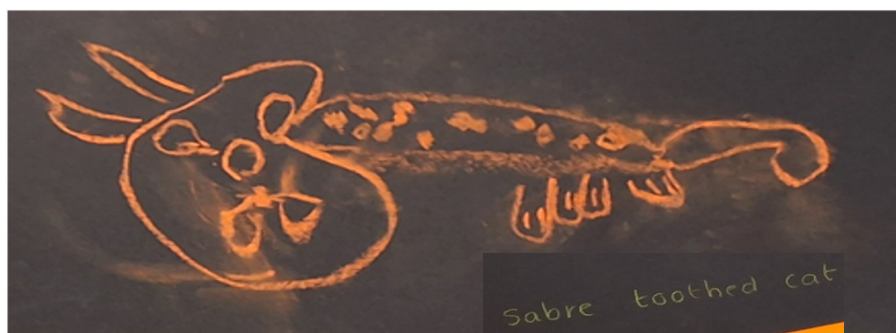
