### Well done to our Year 6 children for their efforts during SATs Week

Firstly, well done to our Year 6 children this week, their focus, discipline and effort did not go unnoticed. Year 6 children across the country have been taking their end of Key Stage 2 SATs tests this week. These tests project and benchmark towards GCSE at secondary school, and can help support where potentially schools might need to improve in English and Maths.

The results demonstrate a summative assessment test of where a Year 6 child has met Government expected standards, working towards these standards or working at a greater depth standard. These results will be released in July and will reported independently to Year 6 parents. Thank you to our Year 6 parents for their support around Government statutory SATs.

Thank you to Miss Walton, Mrs Parry, Mrs Smith, Mrs Gibbens and Mr Hunter (governor), who helped support our Year 6 this week and in the lead up to SATs week. Of course, these tests do not, and cannot, measure what any child is fully capable of. Whatever your views on SATs, we at St Peter's strive to prepare every child for life in Modern Britain and the challenges and excitement this does, and will bring.




# ART


## Swimming
