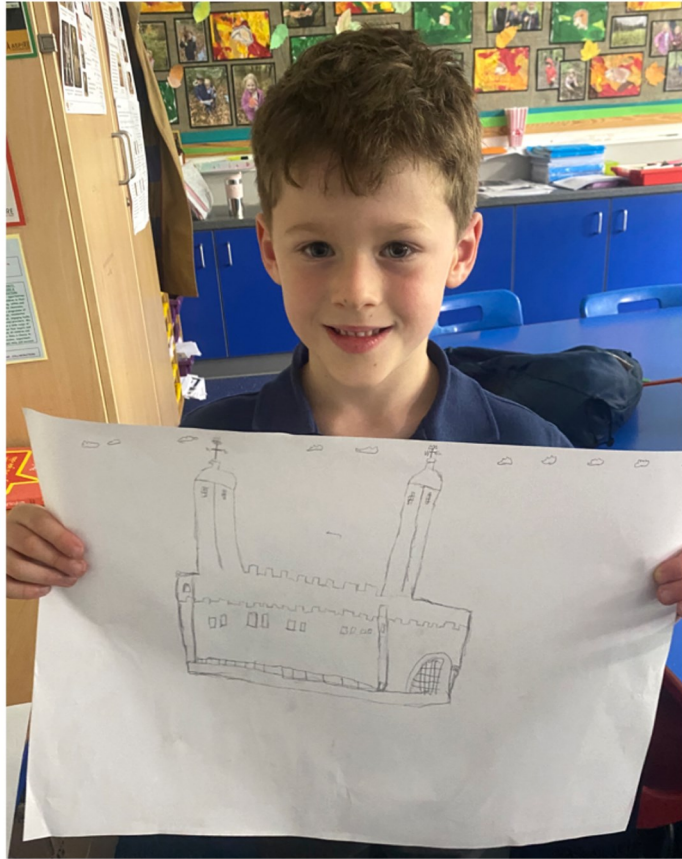

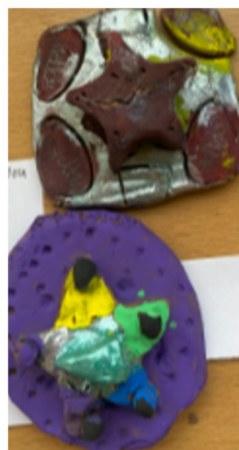

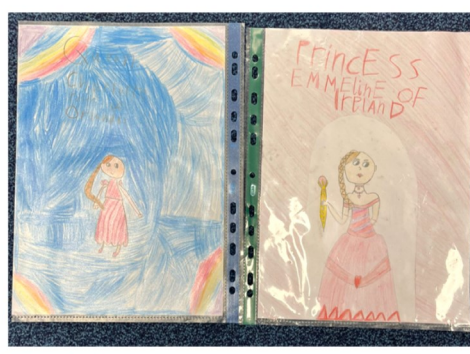

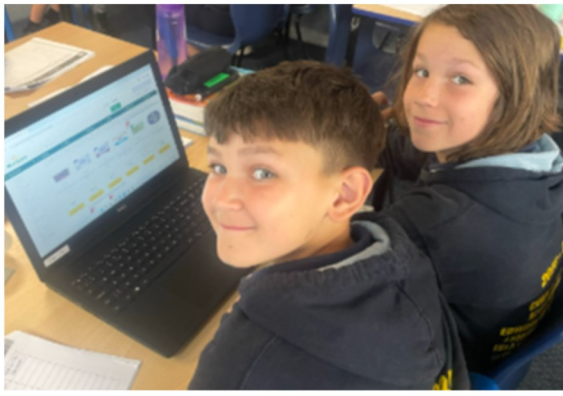
# If I was a monarch...
