**Sam Oldham – inspirational talk and visit.**

This week we were visited by London 2012 Olympic medalist, Sam Oldham. He gave an inspirational talk, about his dreams as a young boy to go to the Olympics. Sam talked about first joining a gymnastics club, the fears he faced, the challenges from his inner voice saying he wasn't good enough and how he trained his inner voice to be his greatest asset. Sam talked about how he was only recently diagnosed as ADHD, he talked about how he made this his super-power throughout his life.

Everyone got to see his Olympic torch and his bronze medal, which took GB men's gymnastics from 23<sup>rd</sup> in the world to 3<sup>rd</sup> in the world!

Every child, from Preschool to Year 6, received a gymnastic masterclass. The Year 6 children received a special mentoring session with Sam about target setting, taking care of your mental health and training your inner voice to be your greatest asset.

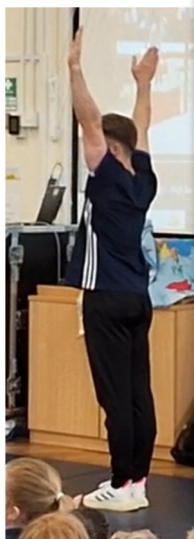

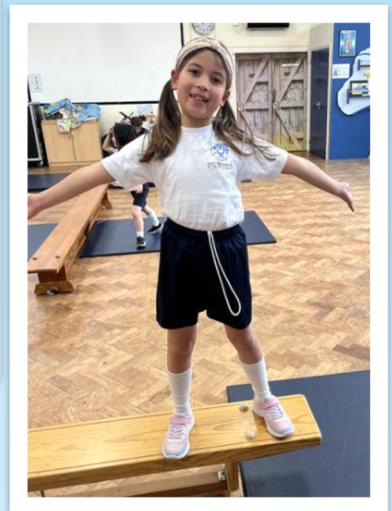

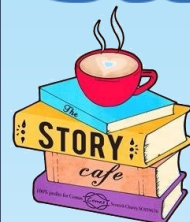
