










Class 3/4 making their clay Islamic relief sculptures

by a number of St Peters Academy pupils and all of them played superb in a super 7 a side match, they all did the school super proud!




Erin (year 1) has completed stage 1 swimming and got her 5 metre badge and she's super proud of herself!
