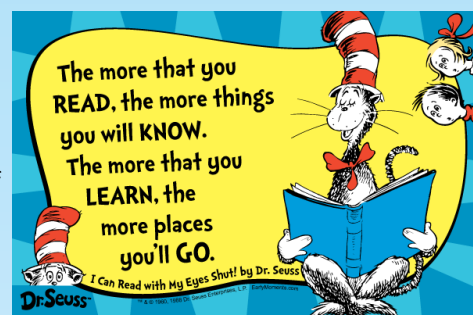


Summer Reading Challenge - 'assembly'
