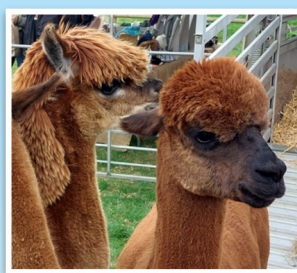
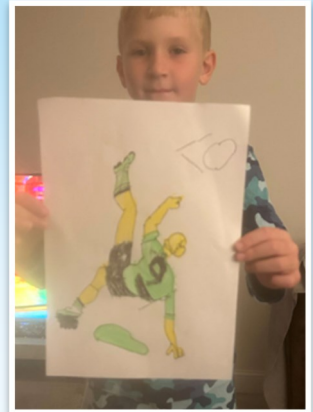


This week in Bible Explorers children learnt about the story of Abraham and Sarah and created these lovely 3D pictures.

### Night Walk

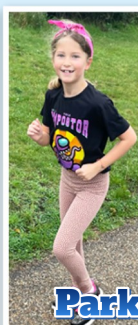
