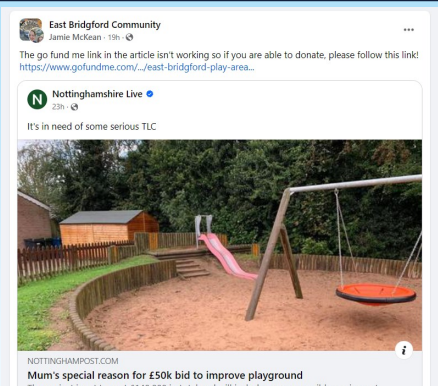

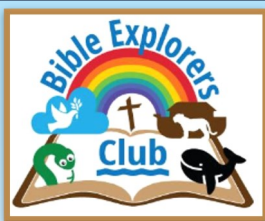

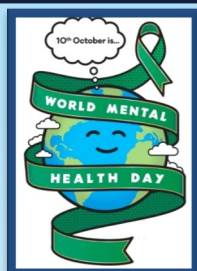
In Bible Explorers this week, children heard the story of Jacob and his 2 wives and made these spinners.



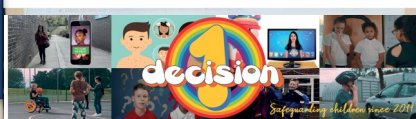
Art from Home
