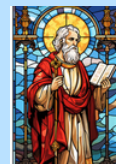

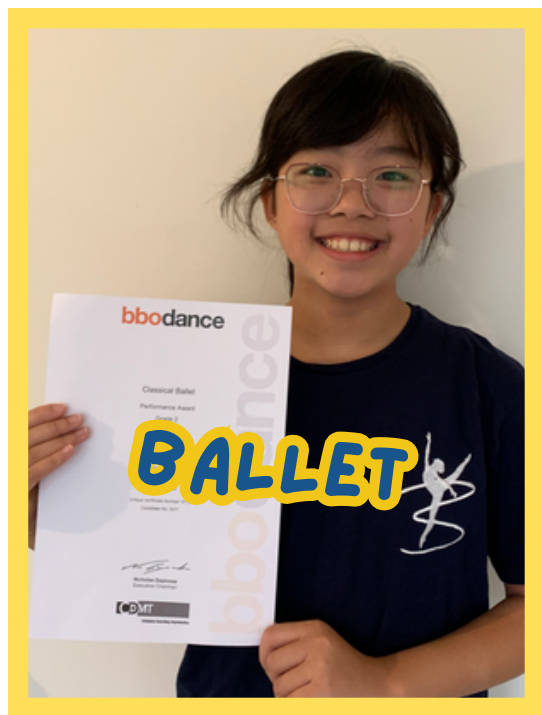

Dorothy has achieved a Distinction\* in her ballet exam. We are very proud of her! Keep up the hard work, well done!

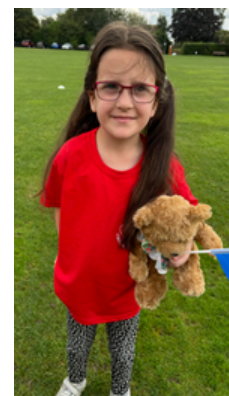
