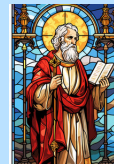

We are SO proud of her!



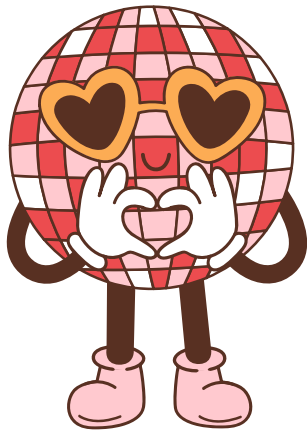
**FUND RAISING CAROL SINGING**
