# <u>Reading Books purchased by you (PTFA) over £10,000</u>

As a school we have been steadily increasing our School Library of books. Recently, we have been able to spend over £2000 on junior reading books specially aimed at making advanced progress in reading. In addition, our juniors are trying out a different style of reading comprehension texts, purchased by PTFA funds, to enhance and progress interpretation and inference, as well as grammar, spelling and punctuation.

Furthermore, our Phonics scheme (Little Wandle) is close to completion with over £8000 spent on progressive groups of phonics books for our younger children. We do ask that you return books to school as missing or damaged books results in the entire group of those books having to be shared or we are unable to use the entire group of books because a handful are still at home or misplaced.




