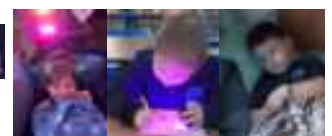

School football had their 1st game of the season away to Flintham school. St Peter's lost 2-0. Many positives from the game with lots of chances created.

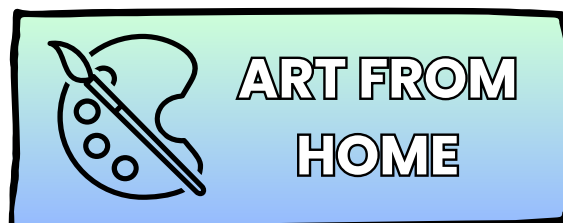

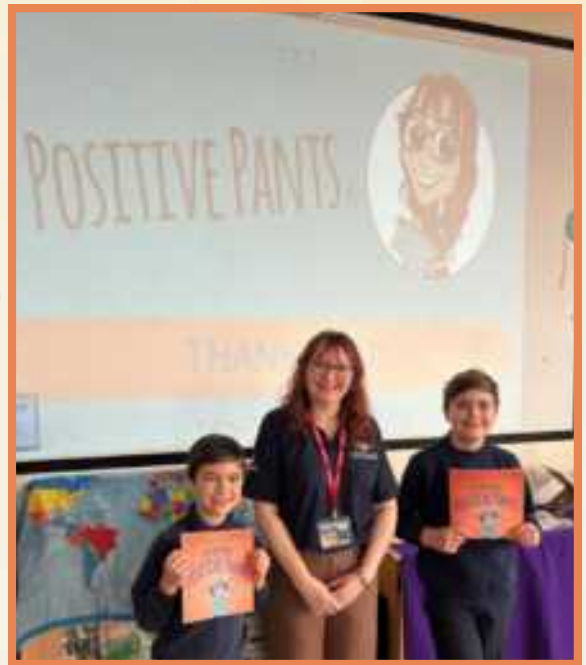

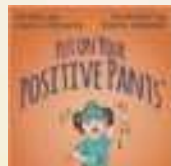
