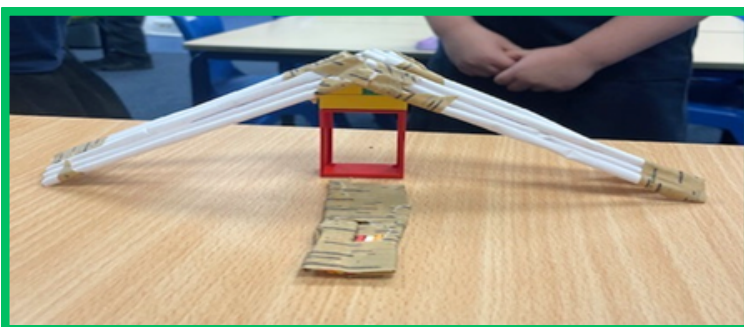
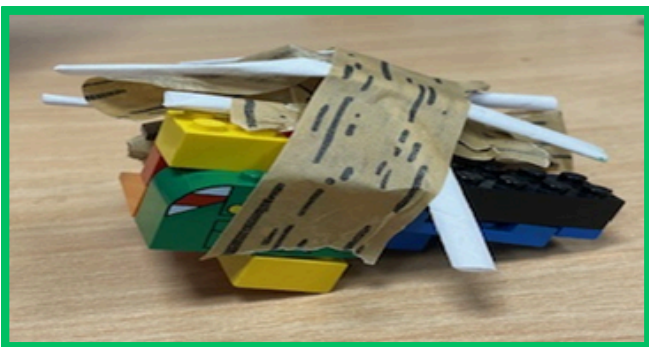
FIR CLASS

The New and Accessible East Bridgford Play Park

Update on the progress to date of the much-needed replacement of the East Bridgford Play Park. The contractors commenced their work on the 23rd September however, progress has been hampered by the stormy UK weather which has caused major issues with the removal of the sand, hardcore and old play park equipment.

The removal is complete however, during this process the contractor has had to access the playing field from the opposite side of the play park with their equipment which has caused a muddy track around the edge of the playing field. This currently means access to and from the playing field on the "Scout Hut/School" side is impassable.

The Parish Council would like to apologise for any inconvenience this has caused. At a meeting today with the Parish Council and the Contractor measures have been agreed that in the short-term temporary boards will be laid down for the pupils to cross the muddy track when going to and from School. The same will also happen for the Schools outdoor PE activities. The boards should be in place by Friday 4th October.

If you could please share this with your family and friends.

We are all so looking forward to having a new and more accessible play park for all our children in the village. If the Parish Council could please ask for your patience at this time.
