






## **Toys Past and Present**

Before half term- Birch class were making hummus in their design and technology topic.




















Y6 work on finding tints, tones and shades in landscape art we had to use watercolour to match the colour that the artist used.












Beech class experimenting with tints, tones and shades.





Recognised for his positioning and passing out of defence. Great work


