They have done a fantastic job!

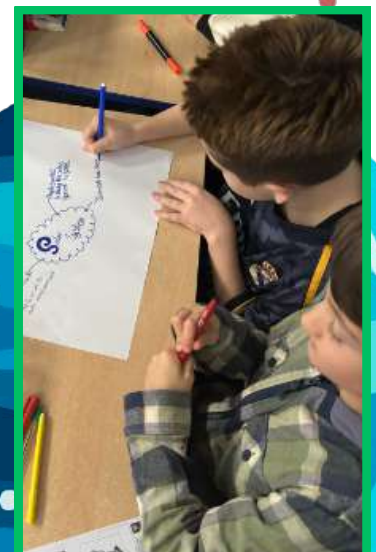
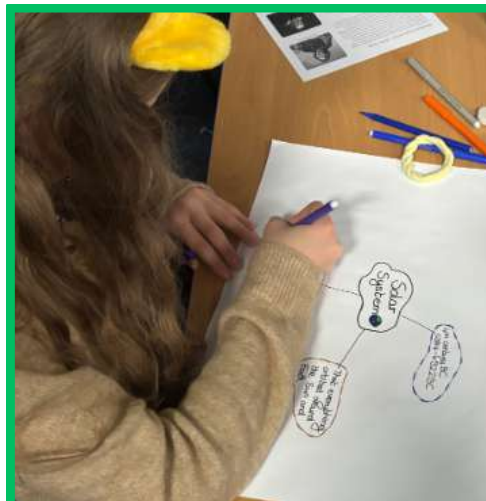
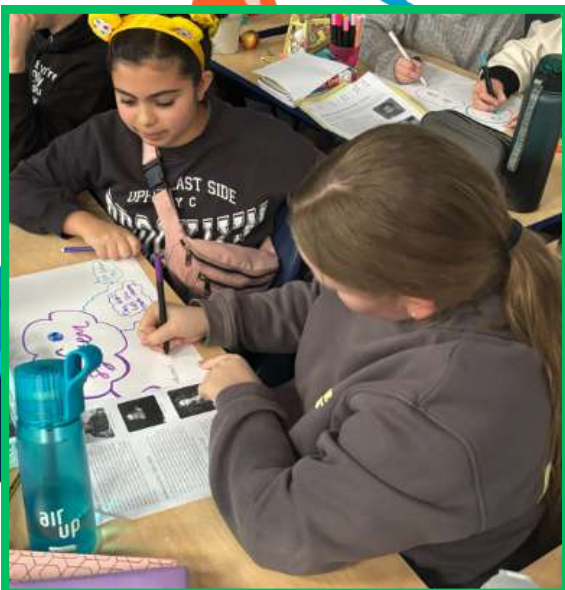
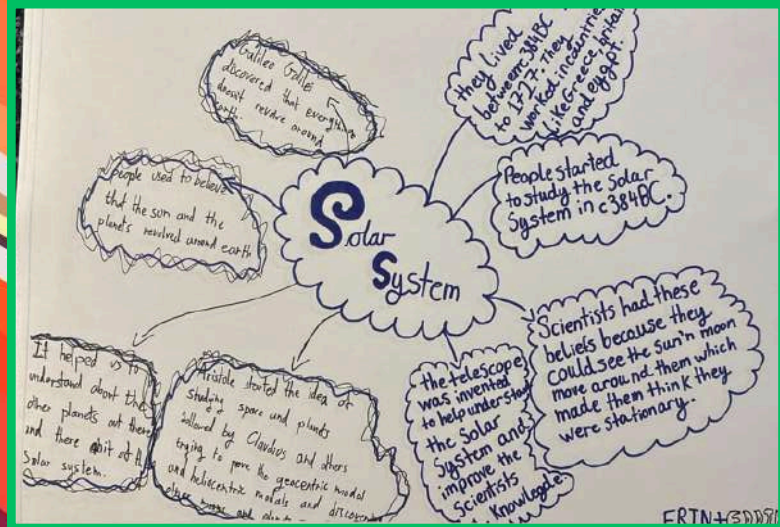
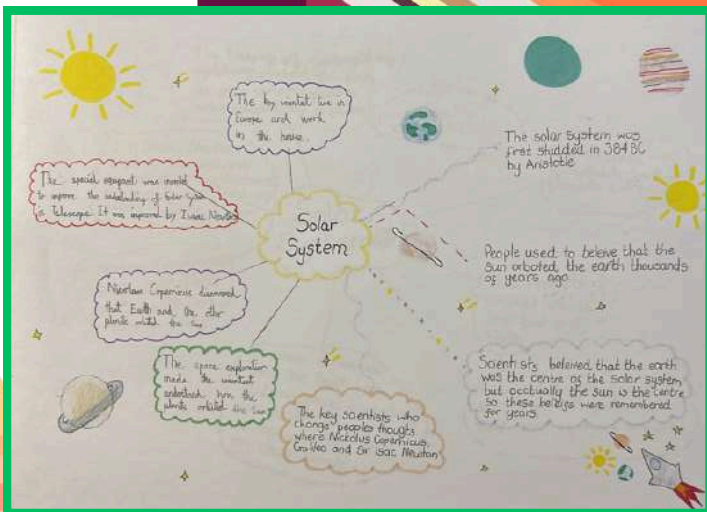
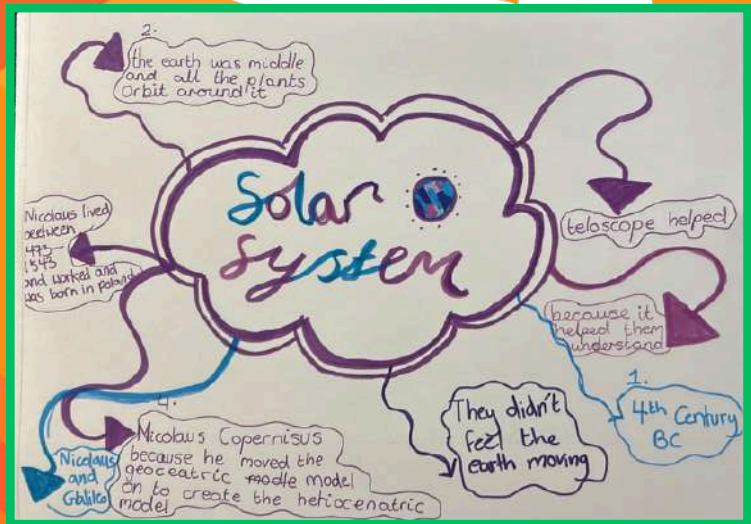




SYCAMORE CLASS
