#### Upcycling preloved school uniform is good for the environment
















The children asked Cazzie some great questions, we found out that she started writing stories at the age of 4! Creating her own version of the Little Miss Books.



They have done a fantastic job!

























Science - We have explored how we know that the sun is the centre of the solar system. We created mind-maps to show our learning!





£30 raised from 23 cakes!!


