- Rules and patterns for each list of words will be taught in daily spelling sessions over the week. Children will continue to be tested in school on the Friday of each week e.g. List 1 will be tested on Friday 21st April and so on.
- As an extension at home, children could find further words that follow the same spelling pattern and/or write sentences to include each word on the list.
- You should also have a copy of the 64 common exception words that Year 2 children are expected to be able to spell by the end of the year.
- Please note that for the final two weeks of this half term (weeks beginning 15<sup>th</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> May) the children will revisit previously learnt spelling rules and patterns in school as they will be completing their Key Stage 1 SATs tests at this time.
