- Rules and patterns for each list of words will be taught in daily spelling sessions over the week. Children will continue to be tested in school on the Thursday of each week e.g. List 1 will be tested on Thursday 18th April and so on.
- As an extension at home, children could find further words that follow the same spelling pattern and/or write sentences to include each word on the list.
- You should also have a copy of the 64 common exception words that Year 2 children are expected to be able to spell by the end of the year.
- Please note that for the final week of this half term (week beginning 20/5/24) the children will revisit previously learnt spelling rules and patterns in school.
