We are very proud of our Year 6 children who have performed exceptionally well in their sats. Having the confidence and support from both home and school has made a tremendous difference.

We are pleased and proud to report our Phonics score this year is 97%. Well done to all the children and staff around teaching phonics. A huge thank you to our PTFA who have contributed, with your support, over £10k investment in Phonics books over the past few years.

Classes for 2025–2026

We're excited to share that the children have now spent time in their new classes and with their teachers for the 2025–2026 school year. It's been wonderful to see them settling in, making new connections, and starting to build those important classroom relationships.

Our mixed classes approach has become necessary due to the varying sizes of year groups across the school. Mixed-age classes bring both opportunities and challenges, and we continue to adapt in ways that best support every child's learning and development.

One of the many benefits of this structure is the chance for children to develop wider friendships, take on different roles in group dynamics, and experience being both the older and younger peer in a classroom setting. It also allows us to manage staffing and curriculum delivery more effectively, always with the aim of meeting children's needs.

Looking ahead, we've reviewed how we teach Maths and are making some exciting changes. A new online approach, which we trialled with Year 6 this year, will be rolled out across Key Stage 2 from the autumn term, helping you stay even more connected with their learning journey.

We also want to acknowledge how important it is for children to maintain a strong sense of identity and belonging within their year group. This is why we continue to prioritise opportunities for cohorts to come together regularly throughout the week and during special events across the year.

Thank you for your ongoing support as we work to create a vibrant and inclusive learning environment for every child.

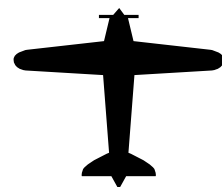
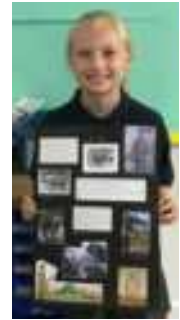

CEDAR CLASS

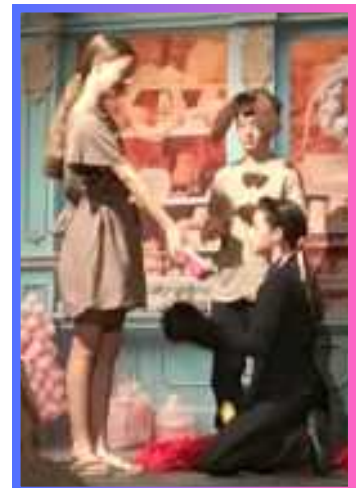
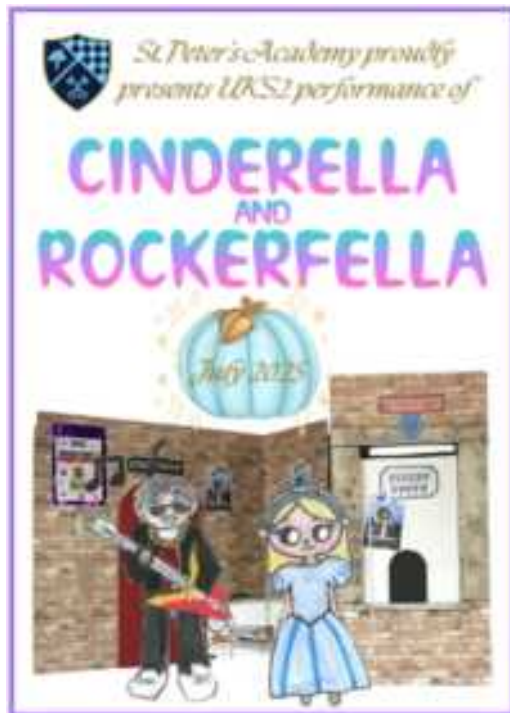
