Dear Parents,

We've had a fantastic week in class! The children have coped brilliantly with the warmer weather, keeping cool, staying in the shade when needed, and remembering to drink plenty of water. Thank you for making sure they come in prepared each day.

This week, we've completed our Talk for Writing unit, and the children have worked incredibly hard to produce some wonderful stories. Their imaginations have really shone through, and we've been amazed by the quality of their descriptive writing. From stretchy, spotty-necked giraffes to monkeys with swishing, twirling tails, their use of rich vocabulary and lively imagery has been a pleasure to read!

In Maths, we've started exploring numbers to 100. The children have been practising counting in 10s and learning how to partition numbers into tens and ones. They're developing a strong understanding of place value and have really enjoyed using the base 10 and one blocks to show their understanding.

We're also really excited about our science work on plants. We've been investigating what a plant needs to grow and will be planting beans next week. This will give the children the chance to observe the growing process and learn more about the different parts of a plant.

In DT, we've been exploring where food comes from. The children are learning about healthy choices and, to end the unit, will be designing and preparing their own healthy sandwiches. Although I have yet to be convinced that chocolate spread and cucumber is both healthy and tasty, I'm sure we're in for some creative (and possibly surprising!) combinations!
