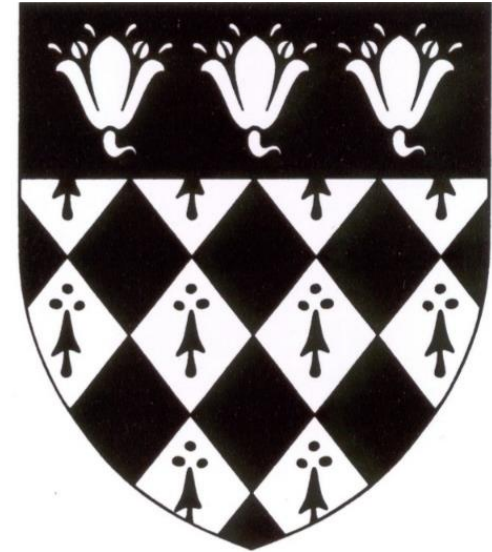

 The original St. Peter's School opened on 4th January 1864 when 26 boys and 17 girls were admitted. 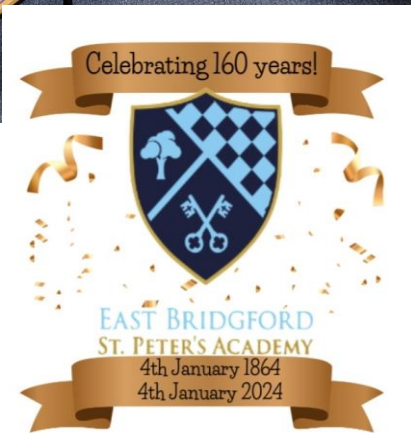

# Our School Rules



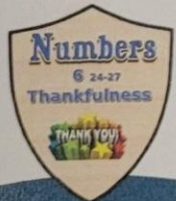

GREEN = is crying  which represents God's sadness for how people can mistreat each other.

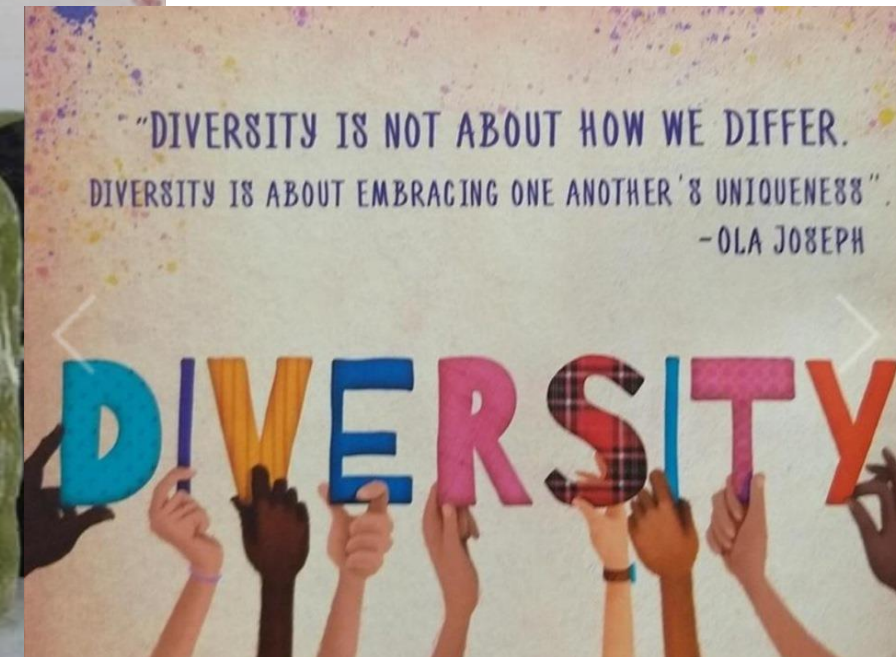
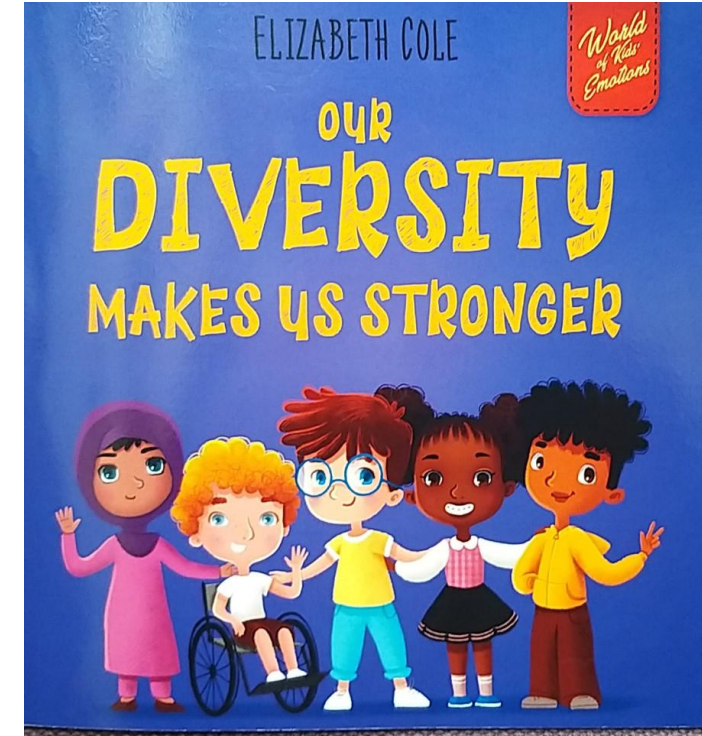
RED = **B** represents blood as Christ died to save us and show us the right way to act (*Integrity*)

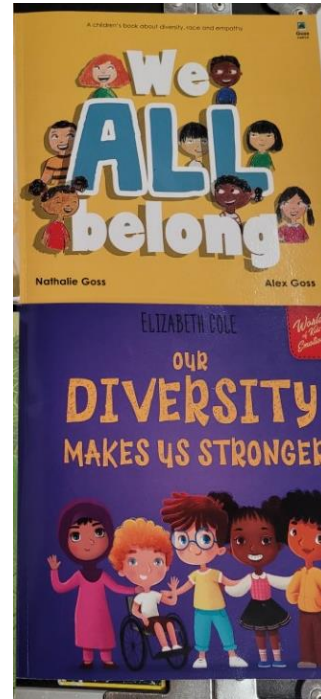
PINK = is a baby which represents being born and a 'child of God' or 'Christian'
