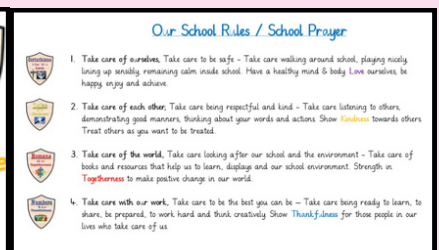
Welcome Back!
