**Infant/KS1 Universal Free School Meals**

This Thursday, 2nd October, is the date we submit our Census Return to the Department for Education. The number of children receiving a **Universal Free School Meal** on this day directly affects the level of funding we receive from the Government for the rest of the year.

We would greatly appreciate your support in ensuring that **all infant children are booked in for a school dinner** on Thursday. On the menu, we have Mrs Plumb's famous **spaghetti bolognaise or vegetarian bolognaise**, as well as **jacket potatoes with cheese/tuna/salad bar**—and for dessert, **yummy sprinkle cake or fresh fruit!**



Unfortunately, lower meal numbers on this specific day can significantly impact our funding and result in a loss of income for St Peter's over an extended period. Thank you for your continued support.

- KS2 (Years 3–6): £3.16 per day / £15.80 per week
- KS1 (Reception, Years 1–2): Meals are free for all KS1 children
- Preschool: £2.10 per day / £10.50 per week
