What another busy couple of weeks we have had!

We all have a fabulous time watching the production of *The Jungle Book* performed by The Image Theatre Company. This is always a lovely way to come together as a whole school and enjoy the arts whilst being introduced to classic stories in a fun and interactive way. The actors told me after that we were the best audience they had had so far for listening and participating. I'm sure you'll agree with me when I say how proud that made me feel.

Whilst discussing reading, I am currently working my way through the class so that I have spent time listening to everyone read. I cannot get through the whole class every week, so it is important that you hear your children read at home too. Thank you to those who have started signing the work diaries whenever you hear your child/children read, practise their spellings or times table (the children know which table they should learn for next week). It really helps show the children that we all work closely together.

**Curriculum:** Over the past two weeks in *Talk 4 Write*, we have learned how to write sentence starters with prepositions, we have included verbs and adverb along with personification and sentences of three (three different bits of information) for Year 4 children. These skills will be revisited often to embed the learning. Next week we shall finish our work on *Red* and complete our *Hot Write*, with a focus on the setting. In Maths we have continued work on place value and have looked at rounding 4 figure numbers to the nearest 10, 100 and 1,000. History continues to look at lives of the Stone Age and in science we have learned all about healthy eating and the 5 main food groups (consolidated by this week's homework). In RE we have discussed 'What kind of world did Jesus want?' We related this our lives and looked at the world as it is now and how we can improve it. The children had lovely ideas to make our world a *Take Care* world.

**HOMEWORK:** I would like you to be creative and design a healthy meal. If you wish, you can make your meal using a paper plate and collage materials (see examples below). Please include all the 5 main food groups if you can. Carbohydrates, Protein, fruit and vegetables, oils and spreads and dairy
