### In English:

- Jack and the Beanstalk in Talk for Writing
- We wrote our final 'tweaked' story where we included our own characters, settings and storyline. We can't wait to share them at parents evening.

### In Topic:

- Science – learning about the importance of a balanced diet and regular exercise in keeping our bodies healthy. The children enjoyed discussing healthy food choices and how different activities help us stay fit and strong.
- Creative Arts – exploring printing with colour. The children have been learning about primary and secondary colours and experimenting with how they can be combined in printmaking.
- RE – We created posters to show ways we can take care of our world. The children came up with thoughtful ideas and used pictures and words to share their messages about looking after the environment.
- PE – invasion games (indoor) and striking and fielding (outdoor)
- Music – Exercise Rhythms, Harvest Hoedown and the Bean Song.
- Geography – looking at sustainability and what we can do as a school and our families to reduce our carbon footprint.
