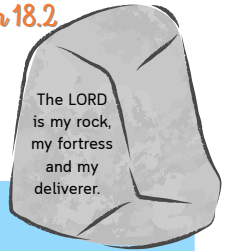

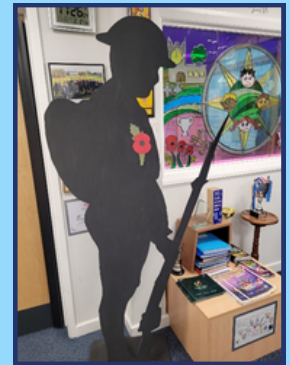
MESSAGE FROM MR TOMLINSON

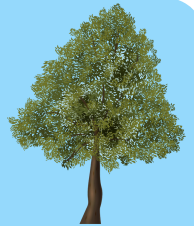



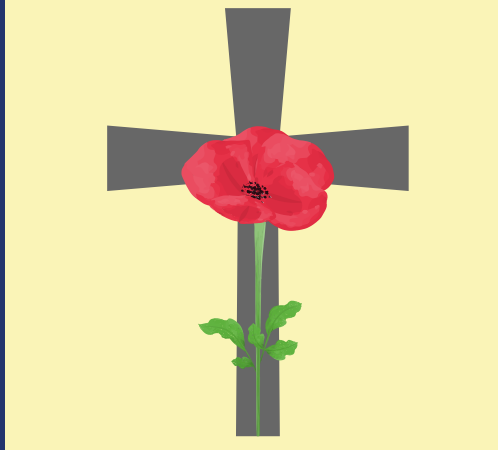



Poppies
