In English:

- We have continued our Talk for Writing unit, *Kassim and the Greedy Dragon*, which focuses on writing a suspense story. This week, we innovated the story as a class by changing the character, setting and danger. The children have produced some great creative writing, and we are really looking forward to seeing their own independent stories next week.

In Topic:

- Science - In science, we looked at the properties of materials and discussed which would work best for different objects. A chocolate teapot was definitely not a good choice!
- Creative Arts - This term's topic is on flowers and week we look at the colours and forms of various flowers
- Computing - We are learning about coding.
