You may have heard last week, we had a visit from the Life Education Team. Our theme was called "It's good to be me." We learned all about the different emotions we can feel and how we can prevent feeling lonely. We learned about how healthy food is good for us and how it travels through our body. Overall, we had a great afternoon. The children listened well and keenly answered all the questions.

Curriculum:

We are really enjoying our topic; we know all about tectonic plates and the Ring of Fire. We looked at longitude and latitude on a world map and learned how to locate the many volcanoes around the world. We will soon be learning more about volcanoes and this is linked to our homework for the following four weeks.

In art we continued with this topic and half the class use inks to block print, whilst the other half used water colours to paint ammonites.

Our science lesson was really exciting and the children loved to see how iron filings could show how invisible magnetic forces worked.

In maths we have started our new unit on Length and measure.

In T4W we have used drama to help us understand dialogue, using actions instead of words.

PE: We will continue to have outdoor PE on WEDNESDAY and indoor on Thursday. Please send appropriate kit - warm clothes for outdoors (hat and gloves on very cold days).

Please continue to hear your child read, practice spelling and tables every week. We are now using the Purple Mash test to help prepare for the end of year test.

This has always proved to be a favourite with the classes I have taught previously and I shall be giving the children 4 weeks to produce their model or craft. I would like everyone to construct a piece of creative work relating to volcanoes. Please include a written summary of the features and how it erupts.
