It will be held outside Scout HQ, straight after school, on Friday 22nd May.

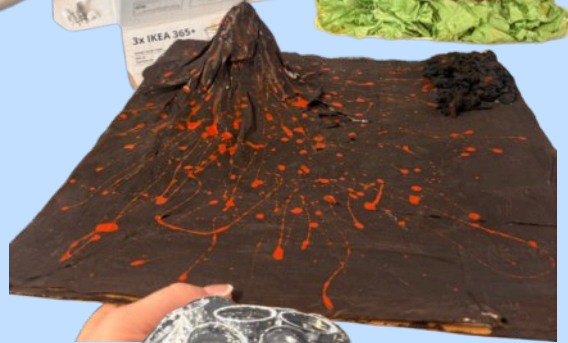
