Infant/KS1 Universal Free School Meals

- KS2 (Years 3–6): £3.16 per day / £15.80 per week
- KS1 (Reception, Years 1–2): Meals are free for all KS1 children
- Preschool: £2.10 per day / £10.50 per week

PACKED LUNCHES

We are a nut-free school. Due to allergies, please do not include any food containing nuts or coconut in your child's packed lunch.
