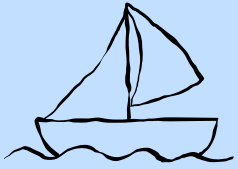

Confusing making you sad and angry.

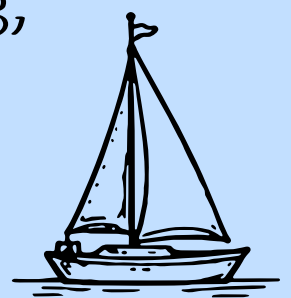
But life is never just easy or

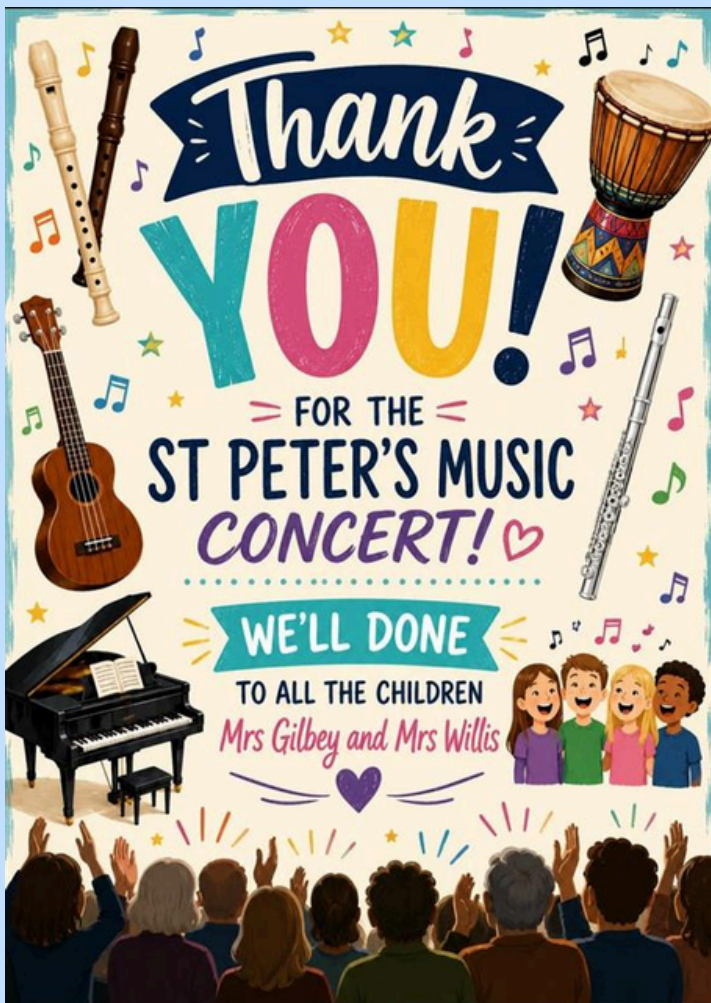
