About the role

This varied and rewarding role will predominantly work across Key Stage 2, supporting pupils with a range of additional needs and barriers to learning.



Working under the guidance of the SENCo and class teachers, the successful candidate will:

- Deliver targeted small group and individual interventions to support learning, confidence and progress.
- Support pupils with SEND and additional needs, primarily across KS2.
- Help implement strategies and provision to enable pupils to access learning successfully.
- Build strong, nurturing relationships that help children feel safe, valued and ready to learn.
- Undertake a small element of planned PPA cover, providing high-quality support and continuity for pupils.
- Support pupils' social, emotional and academic development through inclusive and relationship-based practice.
- Work collaboratively with staff to identify barriers to learning and support positive outcomes.
- Contribute positively to a school culture where every child is encouraged to thrive.

We are looking for someone who:

- Is passionate about inclusion and helping every child succeed.
- Has experience of working with primary-aged children, ideally within Key Stage 2.
- Understands or is keen to further develop expertise in SEND and intervention support.
- Is proactive, adaptable and enjoys variety in their role.
