Hello! Here we are in the last Summer term- already! We have lots of exciting things to look forward to: Ancient Egyptian workshop on 8th June, Dukes Barn, Sports Day, Race for Life, Potted Sports and much more...

Here is what we've been learning:

Maths: In Maths, Year 3s have started their topic of time. This week, they have recapped on how to tell the time to the nearest 5 minutes and 1 minute and how to read both a digital and analogue clock. Any practice of this, little and often, will be of great value. We have enjoyed using the teaching clock for quick practice and recall, of telling the time in analogue. Year 4s are continuing their topic on money and preparing for the multiplication test next week.

History: In our Ancient Civilisation topic this week we have continued enjoying our learning all about Ancient Civilisations, with a focus on Ancient Sumer. Before half term, we learnt what the term 'hierarchy' means and how it applied to the Ancient Sumer civilisation. This week, we will begin our learning on the Ancient Egyptians and understand the lives of those in Ancient Egypt starting with our Ancient Egyptian workshop on Monday!

Art: In Art, we finalised our topic of 'Islamic Art' by creating our final piece of an Islamic geometric tiles, using clay. We carefully sculpted and created an Islamic clay tile, decorating with colours, shapes and geometric patterns.

Reading: It is great to see you all keeping up with your reading done at home. Remember to sign the reads the aim is for children to have at least 3 or more reads per week. For children to gain 'points' towards their bronze, silver, gold and platinum bookmarks, all reading must be signed by an adult by the Friday of each week.
