Curriculum:

We are enjoying learning about the Romans, and this week we found out about what life would have been like for a Roman soldier and about the invasion of Britain. This half term in science we will be learning about Light and Shadow and started by discovering what we already know. This is a great way of ironing out any misconceptions early on. In DT we have had fun testing materials to decide what materials we want to make our greenhouses out of. **I have asked the children to start collecting materials from home to bring into school in the next few weeks.**

English: Our unit 'A finding story' is well under way and we are learning the features needed to write a thoughtful story with a clear beginning and a resolution/ending that offers hope and a great moral. I'm excited to read their stories in the next few weeks.

Maths: In maths we are learning to tell the time. Please support your child as this can be very difficult to teach if your child is unfamiliar with o'clock, half past, quarter past/to and telling the time to the minute.
