<i>In English:</i> During English, we have continued looking at instructions and learning how to write clear steps for making a magical object. <i>Topics:</i> Science: In Science, we have continued our topic on habitats. RE: This week, we started our topic on Jewish and Christian stories. We have been thinking about how and why some stories are important in religion. We are also learning how we can learn from these stories, including those from the Torah and the Bible. This week, we looked at the story of Joseph and explored his feelings. We also talked about things that can make us feel scared and what we can do to help ourselves. Music: This half term, we are learning how to perform songs with instrumental accompaniment. We have enjoying singing and performing songs Humanities (History): In History, we continued our topic on monarchy. Next, we will be learning about Queen Elizabeth II. DT: This half term in DT, we are focusing on materials and sewing. We have begun to think about the designs for our book marks. On Monday, we were lucky to be invited by East Bridgford Bowling Club to go and play bowls with them. We had a very enjoyable afternoon and definitely have some future bowls players in our class!	
<i>In Maths:</i> Year 1: Money In year one we have started looking at time, starting with the months and days of the week. In Year 2, We finished our topic on Statistics and pictograms, how to both draw and interpret them.
